Internationally Known Speaker and Author

As a young man, Josh McDowell considered himself an agnostic. He truly believed that Christianity was worthless. After trusting in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, Josh's life changed dramatically as he experienced the power of God's love.

In 1961, Josh joined the staff of Campus Crusade for Christ International. Not long after, he started the Josh McDowell Ministry to reach young people worldwide with the truth and love of Jesus.

Well known as an articulate speaker, Josh has addressed more than 25 million people, giving over 27,000 talks in 125 countries.



Steve Arterburn

Founder and Chairman, New Life Ministries

Steve Arterburn is the founder and chairman of New Life Ministries and host of the #1 nationally syndicated Christian counseling talk show: *New Life Live!* heard and watched by over 2 million people each week on nearly 200 radio stations nationwide, on XM and Sirius Satellite radio, and on the NRB television network. Steve is also the host of New Life TV, a web-based channel dedicated to transforming lives through God's truth. Steve is the founder of the Women of Faith conferences attended by over 4 million people. He also serves as a teaching pastor in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Steve is a nationally and internationally known public speaker and has been featured in national media venues such as *Oprah*, *Inside Edition*, *Good Morning America*, *CNN Live*, *The New York Times*, *USA Today*, *US News & World Report*, *ABC World News Tonight*, and ironically in *GQ* and *Rolling Stone* magazines. Steve has spoken at major events for the *National Center for Fathering*, *American Association of Christian Counselors*, *Promise Keepers Canada*, *Lifewell Conferences* in Australia and *The Salvation Army* to name a few.

Steve is a best-selling author of books such as *Every Man's Battle*, *Healing Is A Choice* and his latest books, *The 7-Minute Marriage Solution*, *The Book of Life Recovery*, *Is This The One?* and recently co-authored *Worthy of Her Trust* with Jason Martinkus. With over 8 million books in print, he has been writing about God's transformational truth since 1984. He has been nominated for numerous writing awards and has won three Gold Medallions for writing excellence. Along with Dr. Dave Stoop, he edited and produced the #1 selling *Life Recovery Bible*.

His speaking topics address issues common to leaders, adult men and women, including *Every Man's Battle*, *Lose It For Life*, *The 7-Minute Marriage Solution*, *Every Heart Restored*, and *Healing is a Choice*. Steve's ministry endeavors focus on identifying and compassionately responding to the needs of those seeking healing and restoration through God's truth.

Steve has degrees from Baylor University and The University of North Texas as well as two honorary doctorate degrees and is currently completing his doctoral studies in Christian counseling.

Dr. Ted Roberts

Founder, Pure Desire Ministries International

Dr. Ted Roberts served as a USMC fighter pilot and platoon leader, flying close air support missions. In 1970, Ted Roberts met Jesus Christ in a bunker while under a rocket attack in Vietnam. Ted eventually finished his tour in the Marine Corps Squadron VMA-311. Upon returning to the United States, Ted served as a safety officer and flight instructor in Training Squadron VT-21 and attended Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California.

In 1976 the Lord suddenly and unexpectedly changed the course of Dr. Ted's life by calling him into ministry. Having graduated with honors in math and astrophysics, Ted earned his Master's Degree at Asbury Theological Seminary and Doctorate from Western Conservative Theological Seminary. Dr. Ted has served in numerous ministry leadership positions that include; Founder and Clinical Director of Pure Desire Ministries International, Academic Dean of a bible college, and for 23 years Senior Pastor of East Hill Church in Gresham, Oregon. Under Dr. Ted's leadership, and in one of the most unchurched areas of the country, East Hill Church grew to over 7,000 members.

In 2007 Dr. Ted stepped away from the pulpit to engage in a new battle and to commit his time and energy to the development of Pure Desire Ministries International. This time around, the battle is for sexual purity and healing in the church. Dr. Ted has authored 12 books that include

the bestseller, *Pure Desire* and the addiction recovery manual titled *Seven Pillars of Freedom*.

Dr. Ted is a certified sex addiction and multiple addiction professional. He worked closely with IITAP (International Institute for Trauma and Addiction Professionals) and Dr. Patrick Carnes to create an officially recognized designation for pastors (PSAP) who work in the field of sex addiction treatment. Dr. Ted's current roles include Clinical Director, *Pure Desire* Ministries International, conference speaker, and writer.

In 2013 Dr. Ted hosted and was co-writer for the educational video series titled *Conquer Series*. The series also earned a highest recommendation for video documentary from Christian Film Database.

Presently, Dr Ted continues to write. His current work is the development of a relapse prevention manual. Ted and his wife Diane counsel pastors and leaders from around the nation who are trapped in sexual bondage. The couple also travels the world declaring the freedom and grace of Jesus Christ.

Dr. Ted and Diane reside in Gresham Oregon and where they enjoy time with their two adult children and four grandchildren.



Dr. William Struthers

Neuroscientist and Professor of Psychology

Dr. Struthers' lab research interests are in the neural mechanisms that underlie behavioral arousal and the processing of novel environments. His research employs the use of stereotaxic surgery, immunochemistry, and behavioral manipulations to investigate gene expression in the cingulate cortex and basal ganglia.

He is actively involved in the Wheaton College Animal Care and Use Committee and has served as the chair of the Institutional Review Board, committees which oversee the ethical treatment of animals and human subjects in research. His professional memberships include the Society for Neuroscience, Faculty for Undergraduate Neuroscience, Association for Psychological Science, and International Neuroethics Society. He recently received a grant from the Faraday Institute for Science and Religion, an interdisciplinary research enterprise based at St. Edmund's College, Cambridge University (UK) to examine uses and abuses of neuroscience research in society. Dr. Struthers has also been named a Visiting Research Fellow to Biola University's Center for Christian Thought in 2014 for his work on the impact of sexual exploitation on spirituality, and is part of the Oxford Interdisciplinary Seminars in Science and Religion: Bridging the Two Cultures of Science and the Humanities.

Dr. Struthers married his wife in 1993, and they have been blessed with three children. Dr. Struthers was born in Chicago but grew up in north-western Pennsylvania. He is an avid fan of all Pittsburgh sports teams (Steelers, Penguins, and Pirates), J.R.R. Tolkien's writings, and *Battlestar Galactica*. When he finds time, he enjoys reading comic books, supporting Arsenal in the Premier League, and listening to The Call, Joe Satriani, and U2.

Mary Anne Layden, PhD, is a psychotherapist and Director of Education at the Center for Cognitive Therapy at the University of Pennsylvania. She is the Director of the Sexual Trauma and Psychopathology Program and the Director of the Social Action Committee for Women's Psychological Health.

She co-authored the book *Cognitive Therapy of Borderline Personality Disorder* with C. Newman, A. Freeman and S. Morse. She has written numerous chapters on Cognitive Therapy especially on treatment of Borderline Personality Disorder. She has co-authored a chapter with Linnea Smith called "Adult Survivors of the Child Sexual Exploitation Industry" in Cooper, S. et al (Eds) *Medical, Legal, & Social Science Aspects of Child Sexual Exploitation: A Comprehensive Review of Pornography, Prostitution, and Internet Crimes*.



Patrick Trueman

President & CEO, National Center on Sexual Exploitation
Former Chief, Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section,
U.S. Department of Justice

The National Center on Sexual Exploitation is dedicated to changing policies that facilitate sexual exploitation, educating the public about the wealth of social harms that emerge from the production & consumption of pornography, and leading the movement to address the public health crisis of pornography that has been created through unchecked sexual profiteering. As president, Patrick Trueman spearheads efforts to change corporate policies that facilitate sexual exploitation through the Dirty Dozen List. This aggressive project, educates executives, galvanizes public attention, and spurs popular actions to defend human dignity.

Under his leadership, NCOSE has produced policy improvements at a wide range of notable institutions, including Google, Wal-Mart, the Department of Justice, Verizon, the Federal Communications Commission, and more.

In 2015, Mr. Trueman established the NCOSE Law Center, which serves as a resource for legal efforts to combat illegal pornography, sexually oriented businesses, and to bring innovative lawsuits against public institutions facilitating sexual exploitation. In 2010, he founded Porn-HarmsResearch.com to provide peer-reviewed research and talking points on the harms of pornography.

On a global level, Mr. Trueman leads NCOSE's Coalition to End Sexual Exploitation, an international coalition, which boasts nearly 300 organizations and academic experts who are committed to sharing strategies and resources for combating public & private harms caused by pornography.

Patrick Trueman is a former Chief of the Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section, Criminal Division at the U. S. Department of Justice from 1988 to 1993. While there, he supervised the prosecution of child sex crimes, child pornography, and obscenity. He managed an office of twenty of prosecutors and support staff, and worked with the nation's ninety-three United States Attorneys to coordinate federal prosecutions.

During his 37 years as a lawyer, he litigated cases at all levels of the federal system, including in the United States Supreme Court. He has been an advisor to many municipalities on First Amendment law and has helped draft ordinances to end or curb the impact of sexually oriented businesses such as pornography shops, strip clubs, and related establishments. A recognized international expert, Mr. Trueman has traveled to Europe, South American, the Middle East, and other areas to speak about human trafficking or the effects of television sex and violence on the family.

Mr. Trueman served as chief of staff to a Member of the United States Congress. From 1976 to 1982, he was Executive Director and General Counsel to Americans United for Life, a national public interest law firm in Chicago. He lives just outside Washington, D.C., and is married to Laura Clay Trueman. Laura and Pat Trueman have three children, Patrick, Claire, and Elizabeth.



Dawn Hawkins

Vice President & Executive Director, National Center on Sexual Exploitation

Dawn Hawkins is a passionate defender of human rights who has dedicated her life to fighting against societal harms that threaten the dignity of

others. Her energy, creativity and mobilization skills have revived the anti-pornography movement.

As Executive Director of National Center on Sexual Exploitation (NCOSE), Mrs. Hawkins has developed a national strategy uniting conservative, women's rights, child advocacy and religious groups, including a bipartisan political leadership, to work together raising awareness of the pandemic of harm from pornography. Her initiatives have led to sweeping policy changes of policies that foster exploitation for targets such as Google, Hilton Worldwide, Verizon and the Department of Defense. Through her leadership, NCOSE has grown a network reaching hundreds of thousands of people all over the world. Mrs. Hawkins has appeared on many local and national television programs, including Fox & Friends, CNN and Good Morning America. She regularly authors articles and speaks around the country addressing the harms of pornography and all forms of sexual exploitation and what can be done to curb the growing public health crisis resulting from pornography.

Dawn regularly volunteers for organizations devoted to helping children and the homeless. She is a graduate of Tufts University and currently resides with her husband, Michael and two children in Virginia.



Dr. Judith Reisman

Researcher, Author, Historian, and Teacher

As a researcher, author, historian, and teacher, Judith Reisman has focused on pornography as a pandemic, addicting men, women and children. She has also focused on exposing Dr. Alfred C. Kinsey's fraudulent sex science research and education. She has served as a consultant to four U.S. Department of Justice administrations. Her book *Sexual Sabotage* evaluates Dr. Alfred C. Kinsey's research, and how it reshaped America's sexual ethos, sending it into a negative trajectory.

Fr. Sean Kilcawley graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1996 with a BS in Middle East Foreign Area Studies. Kilcawley earned a Masters of Divinity and a STB from St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in 2005 and then served the diocese of Lincoln for four years as a high school teacher of religion and parochial vicar. In 2013, Fr. Kilcawley completed an STL (summa cum

laude) at the John Paul II institute for marriage and family in Rome. He currently serves as Diocesan Director of the Office of Family Life and Evangelization for the Diocese of Lincoln. He also serves on the board for the Integrity Restored network.

Jayson Graves, M.MFT, husband of Susan and father of Selah Rae & Asabella, is a Christian psychotherapist specializing in Sexual Addictions Recovery and unwanted attractions. He enjoys helping his clients from both a clinical and personal frame as a person in recovery himself.

While receiving his Masters in Marriage & Family Therapy from Seattle Pacific University, the bulk of his experience has come from working with youth, in community mental health and men's ministry. Since then, Jayson has enjoyed working with couples, individuals, young adults and teens in private practice. His passion is to see people set free from sexual addictions, unwanted attractions and other relational struggles through forgiveness, reconciliation, accountability, faith and purity.

Since 1994, she has been a pioneering leader on the frontlines of U.S. efforts to make the Internet safer for children and families by implementing a three-pronged strategy of the public, the technology industry and legal community sharing the responsibility to protect children online. This strategy has been adopted by industry and governments worldwide.

Under her leadership, EIE created the Internet Safety 101® Program with U.S. Department Of Justice. She is the Executive Producer, and host of the Internet Safety 101® DVD series which was reformatted into the Internet Safety 101 ® Television Series for PBS and earned an Emmy Award.

She has given more than 4,000 media interviews on the topic, testified numerous times before Congress, and most recently won the 2013 Women in Technology Award for Social Impact and the 2014 Professional Women in Advocacy Excellence in Advocacy Award for "Veteran Practitioner."
